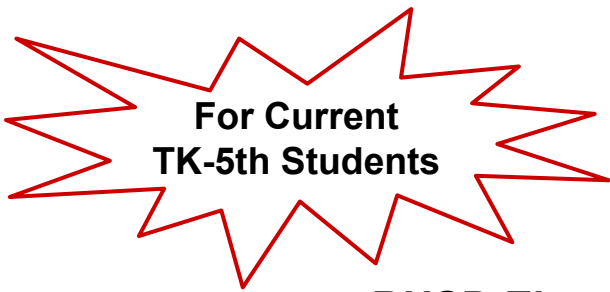

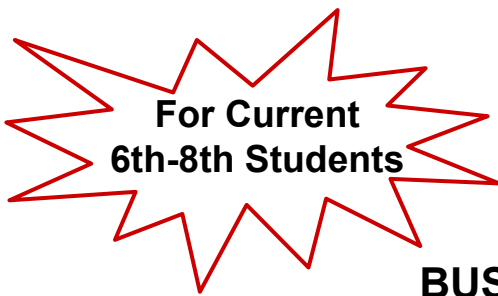
City of Berkeley Scholarship Information

Berkeley Public Schools will provide a variety of summer options to support **learning recovery** and provide **social-emotional learning**. Students who are recommended by school counselors are invited to enroll. **Enrollment begins after spring break.**

All **Extended School Year (ESY)** students are automatically enrolled. Curriculum will include:

- High interest texts, review and practice of academic writing structures, and hands-on math
- Positive Reinforcement systems focusing on community and relationships
- Support for students with moderate to severe disabilities in attaining and generalizing the critical skills, self-sufficiency, and/or functional goals essential to the student's continued progress
- Support in functional academic skills and social skills that encompass a variety of educational and daily living skills

No School July 5

English Language Development (ELD) is geared towards accelerating English language development of ELD 1/2 students.

Credit Recovery classes are open to current 11th grade students for remediation only, which means either to raise an existing grade from "D" or "F" in a class a student has already taken, or to make-up a missed grade-level class.

The **Senior Diploma** program may be recommended to Current Seniors short up to 15 credits for graduation.

CTE Robotics Camp is a fun, hands-on robotics class.
